



ECHOES OF TRUTH FROM THE QURAN By McIntosh Chimeziri

Dear Muslim brother/sister, do you want to know the truth and nothing but the whole truth about your relationship with God? Then read this booklet with an open mind.

Truth is revealed by asking the right questions. The following are important religious questions with answers based on the Quran.

1. Is the Bible the word of God?

وَأَنزَلَ يَدَيْهِ بَيْنَ لِمَا مُصندِقًا بِٱلْحَقِّ ٱلْكِتَٰبَ عَلَيْكَ نَزَّلَ وَأَنزَلَ يَدَيْهِ بَيْنَ لِمَا مُصندِقًا بِٱلْحَقِّ ٱلْإِنجِيلَ ٱلتَّوْرَلةَ

"He has sent down upon you, [O Muhammad], the Book in truth, confirming what was before it. And He revealed the Torah and the Gospel" (Quran 3:3).

God revealed the Torah and the Gospel (the Bible). Since the Quran was sent to confirm the Bible, then anything in the Quran that contradicts the Bible must have been inserted by someone sinister.

2. Is the Bible corrupted?

وَلَقَدْ كُذِّبَتْ رُسُلٌ مِّن قَبْلِكَ فَصنبَرُواْ عَلَىٰ مَا كُذِّبُواْ وَلَقَدْ كُذِّبَواْ وَلَا مُبَدِّلَ لِكَلِمُتِ ٱللَّهِ وَلَقَدْ وَأُوذُواْ حَتَّى أَتَاهُمْ نَصْرُنَا وَلَا مُبَدِّلَ لِكَلِمُتِ ٱللَّهِ وَلَقَدْ جَاءَكَ مِن نَّبَإِيْ ٱلْمُرْسَلِينَ جَاءَكَ مِن نَّبَإِيْ ٱلْمُرْسَلِينَ

"And certainly were messengers" denied before you, but they were patient over [the effects of] denial, and they were harmed until Our victory came to them. And none can alter the words of Allah..." (Quran 6:34).

"And the word of your Lord has been fulfilled in truth and in justice. **None can alter His words**, and He is the Hearing, the Knowing" (Quran 6:115)

"For them are good tidings in the worldly life and in the Hereafter. **No change is there in the words of Allah**. That is what is the great attainment" (Quran 10:64)

The Quran clearly states that God's word cannot be corrupted. The claim the Bible was corrupted is therefore an empty claim. Anyone who claims that the original Bible was corrupted accuses God of failure to protect His word. That is blasphemy. Moreover, such a one should be able to provide a copy of the "original Bible".

3. Why should a Muslims study the Bible?

"Say O People of the Scripture! Ye have naught (of guidance) till ye observe the Torah and the Gospel and that which was revealed unto you from your Lord. That which is revealed unto thee (Muhammad) from thy Lord is certain to increase the contumacy and disbelief of many of them. But grieve not for the disbelieving folk" (Quran 5:68).

فَإِن كُنتَ فِى شَكِّ مِّمَّا أَنزَلْنَا إِلَيْكَ فَسْئِلِ ٱلَّذِينَ يَقْرَءُونَ الْكَوْنَنَ مِنَ الْكُونَنَ مِنَ الْمُمْتَرِينَ الْمُمْتَرِينَ الْمُمْتَرِينَ

"And if thou (Muhammad) art in doubt concerning that which We reveal unto thee, then question those who read the Scripture (that was) before thee. Verily the Truth from thy Lord hath come unto thee. So be not thou of the waverers" (Quran 10:94).

By the above commands from Allah, ,every Muslim must study the Bible and must depend on "people of the book" (Jews and Christian) for proper understanding of the word of God.

4. What is the punishment for disobeying the Bible?

إِنَّ ٱلَّذِينَ كَفَرُواْ وَظَلَمُواْ لَمْ يَكُنِ ٱللَّهُ لِيَغْفِرَ لَهُمْ وَلَا لِيَهْدِيهُمْ طَرِيقًا لِيَهْدِيهُمْ طَرِيقًا إِلَّا طَرِيقَ جَهَنَّمَ خُلِدِينَ فِيهَا أَبَدًأَ وَكَانَ ذَلِكَ عَلَى ٱللَّهِ يَسِيرًا اللَّهُ يَسِيرًا

"Lo! those who disbelieve and deal in wrong, Allah will never forgive them, neither will He guide them unto a road, Except the road of hell, wherein they will abide for ever. And that is ever easy for Allah" (Quran 4:168-169).

5. Who is Jesus Christ?

This is one question with several answers.

- I. He is the Word of God (Quran 3:45)
- II. He is the miracle worker (Quran 3:49).
- III. He is the Spirit of God (Quran 21:91).

6. What is special about Jesus Christ?

I. Jesus is the only Messiah (Quran 3:45). That word "Messiah" means "the anointed Saviour". It implies that none can be saved eternally without Jesus the Christ. No other person living or dead is referred to as "the

Messiah". Thus "Jesus said... "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me" (John 14:6). On several occasions, Jesus revealed himself as the Christ/Messiah . See also Matthew 16:20, John 8:24.

- II. He is the Lamb of God that removes the sins of all mankind (John 1:29).
- III. He is holy (sinless) (Quran 19:19). He is the only person that lived on earth that is declared "holy". In contrast, Muhammed was commanded to confess his sins (Quran 40:55; 47:19; 48:2.).

- IV. He is *the* truth (Quran 19:34). That means that Christ is the ultimate truth. One who does not have Christ does not have the ultimate truth. No other person can be "the truth".
- V. He is the only being conceived of the Holy Spirit (Quran 21:91, 66:12).
- VI. He is the only being born by a virgin (Quran 3:45-47).

7. Is Jesus Christ the Son of God?

- I. He was conceived by God's Spirit, therefore He cannot be less than the Son of God (Quran 21:91).
- II. Jesus is sinless (Quran 19:19). Only God is sinless.

- III. Prophet Isaiah says that Jesus Christ is the Son of God (Isaiah 9:6)
- IV. The gospels affirm that Jesus Christ is the Son of God (Mark 1:1, Luke 1:35, John 20:31).
- V. To deny what the prophets and the gospels say is blasphemy (Quran 3:3).

8. Does the Quran deny the Sonship of Jesus?

"And (we believe) that He - exalted be the glory of our Lord! - hath taken neither wife nor son" (Quran 72:3).

Even the Bible does not teach that Jesus is a biological son (Arabic - walad) of God. Indeed, God is a Spirit (John 4:23). Spirits do not marry.

Jesus is the Son (Arabic - ibn) of God in the sense that He proceeds from God. His unique conception and His miracles all prove that Jesus proceeds from God (John 8:42; 13:3).

God Himself calls Jesus "My Son" (Matthew 3:17, 17:5).

9. Is Jesus Christ God?

Yes, Jesus Christ is God because

- I. He gave life (Quran 3:49). Only God can give life (Quran 10:34). Jesus is thus God manifested in human form (John 1:14).
- II. He forgives sins (Mark 2:5-7). Only God forgives one's sins.
- III. Prophet Isaiah says that Jesus
 Christ is God; "For unto us a Child is
 born, Unto us a Son is given; And the
 government will be upon His
 shoulder. And His name will be called
 Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God,
 Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
 God is one but manifests as three
 Persons (Matthew 28:19). Even the
 Quran agrees with that as the

- collective pronoun "We" is used in reference to Allah. E.g Quran 2:3.
- IV. The Psalms says that He is God (Psalms 45:1-7).
- V. The gospels say that Jesus Christ is God? (John 1:1)
- VI. Jesus Himself says that He is God (John 8:58,10:30-33).

10. What is special about being a Christian?

"Then We caused Our messengers to follow in their footsteps; and We caused Jesus, son of Mary, to follow, and gave him the Gospel, and [We] placed compassion and mercy in the hearts of those who followed him. But monasticism they invented - We ordained it not for them - only seeking Allah's pleasure, and they observed it not with right observance. So We give those of them who believe their reward, but many of them are evil-livers" (Quran 57:27).

إِذْ قَالَ ٱللَّهُ يُعِيسنَى إِنِّى مُتَوَفِّيكَ وَرَافِعُكَ إِلَىَّ وَمُطَهِّرُكَ مِنَ ٱلَّذِينَ كَفَرُواْ وَجَاعِلُ ٱلَّذِينَ ٱتَّبَعُوكَ فَوْقَ ٱلَّذِينَ كَفَرُواْ

إِلَىٰ يَوْمِ ٱلْقِيمَةِ ثُمَّ إِلَىَّ مَرْجِعُكُمْ فَأَحْكُمُ بَيْنَكُمْ فِيمَا كُنتُمْ فِيمَا كُنتُمْ فِيهِ تَخْتَلِفُونَ فِيهِ تَخْتَلِفُونَ

(And remember) when Allah said: O Jesus! Lo! I am gathering thee and causing thee to ascend unto Me, and am cleansing thee of those who disbelieve and am setting those who follow thee above those who disbelieve until the Day of Resurrection. Then unto Me ye will (all) return, and I shall judge between you as to that wherein ye used to differ" (Quran 3:55). The above passages states that Christians are superior to all non Christians. This will be till the last day.

11. Why should you be a Christian?

- I. No one can be righteous without the grace and mercy of God (Quran 24:21).
- II. Jesus Christ is the Mercy and grace of God (Quran 19:21, John 1:17).
- III. Being a Muslim makes you a slave (Quran 25:63, 37:169) but being a Christian makes you a son/daughter of God (John 1:12).
- IV. Unless one becomes a Christian, he/she is condemned to hell fire (John 3:16-18).
- V. Prophet Jeremiah says that the system of worship which Muslims

- practice was abolished (Jeremiah 31:31-32).
- VI. Even Jesus says that all religions based on special geographical locations were abolished while He was on earth (John 4:20-26, Matthew 18:20).

but a plain warner" (Quran 46:9). In contrast to that, Jesus knows both His fate and that of His followers. Hear Him; "Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me, In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also ... I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. The Father Revealed" (John 14:1-6).

- VIII. The bible says nothing about Islam.
- IX. Jesus is the only way to salvation (John 14:6).

12. How does one become a Christian?

- I. **Believe the gospel.** The gospel is the good news about the life, death, burial and resurrection of Jesus for the sins of all of mankind (John 3:16-18).
- II. **Repent of your sins** (Luke 13:3, 5). To repent is to turn away from bad thoughts and behaviours.
- III. Confess Jesus Christ as the Son of God (Matthew 10:32).

- IV. Be baptized (Mark 16:15-16, John 3:3-5).
- V. Continue to worship with the Church of Christ till death (Mathew 16:18).

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
